<b>Content Accuracy</b>	All content throughout the presentation is accurate. There are no factual errors.	The content is generally accurate, but one piece of information is clearly flawed or inaccurate.	Content is typically confusing or contains more than one factual error.
<b>Sequence of information</b>	Information is organized in a clear, logical way. It is easy to anticipate the type of material that might be on the next slide.	Some information is logically sequenced. An occasional slide or item of information seems out of place.	There is no clear plan for the organization of information.
<b>Spelling and grammar</b>	Presentation has no misspellings or grammatical errors.	Presentation has 1-2 grammatical errors or misspellings.	Presentation has more than 2 grammatical and/or spelling errors.
<b>Originality</b>	Presentation shows considerable originality and inventiveness. The content and ideas are presented in a unique and interesting way. Everything is in students' own words. Presentation is a rehash of other people's ideas and/or graphics and shows very little attempt at original thought. Information is copied and pasted from other places.
<b>Images</b>	All images are attractive (size and colors) and support the theme/content of the presentation.	All images are attractive but a few do not seem to support the theme/content of the presentation.	Several images detract from the content of the presentation.
